Fraudulent Alleged Case

Dear Ms. Payne,

I have reviewed your account regarding the above referenced tax year and have determined our original assessment to be correct.

Based on the Federal Account transcript, the IRS allowed an Earned Income Credit (EIC) in the amount of \$4,736.00.
