Dear Mr. Valentine-Dey:

Thank you for your February 13, 2013 letter to former Commissioner Astrue about the Social Security program. People cannot voluntarily end their participation in the program. Under Federal law, it is mandatory that everyone pay Social Security taxes, regardless of the citizenship or place of residence of either the employer or the employee. Unless specifically exempt by law, everyone working in the United States must pay Social Security taxes.

Similarly, people cannot withdraw the Social Security taxes that they have already paid. We do not place Social Security taxes paid by employees and employers in individual accounts but use them to pay benefits to workers and their families today. A person must voluntarily file an application to receive these benefits.

The law (Section 205 of the Social Security Act) requires the Social Security Administration to maintain records of workers' earnings and to establish any other records necessary to carry out our responsibilities under the Social Security Act. Since many people have the same name, or change their name, we needed a reliable and permanent system to distinguish one individual from another in our records. Congress established the Social Security number system to meet that need.

The Supreme Court has upheld the constitutionality of the Social Security system, as established by the Social Security Act, and mandatory individual participation. We will not respond further to your correspondence about voluntary participation in the Social Security program or the withdrawal of Social Security taxes.

The Internal Revenue Service has jurisdiction over the issue of liability for Social Security taxes; the United States Citizenship and Immigration Services has jurisdiction over the issue of citizenship. If you have questions about those subjects, you should contact one of those offices.
