This will acknowledge receipt of your claim.

The Maryland Tort Claims Act (Section 12-101, *et. seq.* of the State Government Article) establishes very strict standards under which a claim may be considered by the State Treasurer. In particular, the Maryland Tort Claims Act permits the Treasurer to pay only those claims in which the State is determined to be at fault.

This is to advise you that the Maryland Tort Claims Act (Section 12-103) does not apply to a bi-county unit, county, municipal corporation, or other political subdivision or any unit, or official or employee of any of those agencies or subdivisions. Therefore, to protect your rights, we suggest that you pursue your claim with the appropriate local government involved.
